

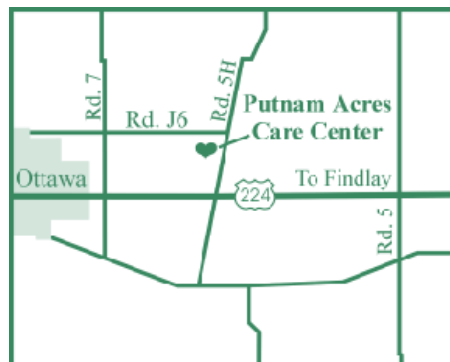


## Intergenerational Learning

## Preschool

The preschool program focuses on increasing each child's independence within a caring and safe environment while well preparing each child for kindergarten entry. The curriculum is based on the Ohio Department of Education Academic Content Standards for Pre-Kindergarten. Each day preschoolers will be given a wide variety of learning opportunities in which to develop and enhance their skills in the areas of cognitive, social/emotional, motor (large and small), and spiritual development. Intergenerational activities will be part of the daily curriculum in which Preschoolers and Elders will engage in learning centers such as reading books or pretend play. By engaging in learning centers, small and large group times and intergenerational experiences, the children will move toward greater independence, higher skill levels and emotional/social maturity.



## After School Care

Putnam Acres Intergenerational Learning Center provides a unique before- and after-school learning experience to keep your school age child motivated and focused within a fun and stimulating environment. Some of the program features include homework support, fitness activities, and the opportunities for intergenerational experiences. The program will provide a comfortable environment where your child will learn to build confidence, self esteem, character, social skills, and empathy.
